

Subject: Revision of CLP

Dear brethren,

Peace!

We have revised the CLP and now call it the Christian Life Seminar (CLS). Instead of 13 sessions, there are now just 9 sessions. They are divided into 3 modules of 3 sessions each.

We have removed 4 sessions, as follows:

- 1) Orientation – if adequate personal evangelization work is done, this introductory session is not critical.
- 2) Who is Jesus Christ? – considering that CLS participants are Christians, this is not crucial for the process of personal renewal in Christ.
- 3) The Christian Family – this will be taken up in the Covenant Recollection (CR); moving this out enables us to have a generic CLS for all adult family ministries.
- 4) Transformation in Christ and dedication – dedication is deferred until after the CR.


The CLS has been shortened but is still long enough to afford adequate time for personal renewal in Christ.

Right after the CLS, the participants are not asked to make their commitment but rather are invited to experience households. Then they take the CR. Only after the CR are they formally dedicated to CFC-FFL.
